## Directions to the EEMUA Office

The easiest way to find the EEMUA office is by using public transport. If you drive into London you will need to pay the Congestion Charge in advance.

### BY UNDERGROUND

The nearest underground station to Black Friars Lane is **Blackfriars Station** on both the Circle and District lines.

#### **From Blackfriars Underground Station**


After you pass through the ticket barrier, **turn right** out of the station heading towards Queen Victoria Street. Cross the road and head right. Turn left onto Black Friars Lane just after the bridge. The EEMUA office is located on the right hand side. The journey should take 4 minutes.

### BY TRAIN

#### **From Blackfriars Station**

Venturing out of the North Bank station exit onto Queen Victoria Street, cross the road and head right. Turn left onto Black Friars Lane just after the bridge. The EEMUA office is located on the right hand side. The journey should take 4 minutes.

When you reach 16 Black Friars Lane, press the button marked **EEMUA** and use the entry phone to let us know you have arrived. We will then release the door lock to allow you to enter the building. The EEMUA offices are on the second floor. There is a lift located in the reception area, however please be aware that this requires an access code. You should therefore wait in reception and a member of staff will come down to greet you and take you to the second floor.



## ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

### **From Kings Cross/Euston/St. Pancras**

From Euston take the Northern line (Charing Cross branch) to Embankment. From here, take the District or Circle line to Blackfriars and follow the directions above. The tube journey is estimated to take under 15 minutes.

Alternatively, there are frequent direct Thameslink trains from St. Pancras to Blackfriars.

### **Travelling to the London area**

The nearest mainline stations to Black Friars Lane are: Blackfriars, City Thameslink and Cannon Street. The nearest airport is London City airport: from here, use the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) towards Bank Station and change to the District Line to Blackfriars Underground Station
